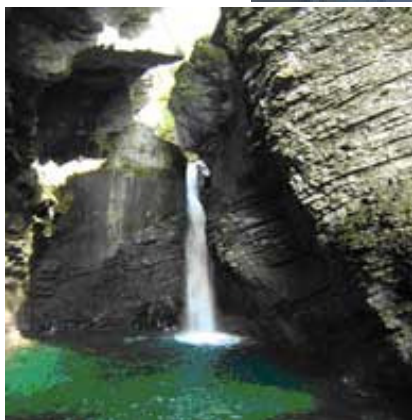


CROATIA GEMS

Chalet Chandon, Boveč, Slovenia

Sleeps 6 + 2 | 2 Double Bedrooms, 1 twin bedroom plus Sofa bed | 2 Bathrooms



Description

We are excited to offer this newly renovated house in Bovec, a lovely alpine village at the head of the beautiful Soca River valley in the Julian Alps. Situated on the edge of the Triglav national park, this area is a paradise for any one who is interested in outdoor activities, whatever the time of year, but is also a great place to relax and enjoy the local food and wine in beautiful surroundings. Bovec is situated approximately 1.5 hours drive from three different airports - Trieste, Klagenfurt and Ljubljana and is also 2.5 hours from Venice. The house is only two minutes walk from the shops, restaurants & bars and the ski-lift is two minutes by car or ski-bus!

A fantastic variety of activities are available in and around this area. In the Winter months Bovec is well known for skiing on the Kanin, which is the highest ski area in Slovenia and which will soon also link to the neighbouring resort over the Italian border. Also popular in this area is floodlit sledging and also dog-sledging in the beautiful local valley of Koritnica. In the summer months Bovec offers wonderful hiking suitable for all levels from a gentle walk and a picnic in the forest or by the startling blue/green of the river, to a full-on days' trekking in the gorgeous Julian Alps. Also mountain biking is very popular and the main cable car continues to run and you can take your bike up to one of the transit stations and make your way back down through a variety of tracks to the village. The Soca river comes into it's own from April onwards with kayaking, white water rafting, canyoning and world class fly-fishing all available locally. Instruction courses from beginner to expert can be arranged in the village. There is a lovely 18-hole golf course just half an hour away. Paragliding is also very popular & can be arranged locally. You can see that you will never be short of something to do in this area but if you are not feeling so energetic, the local food and wine is excellent and can be enjoyed at a variety of restaurants at very reasonable prices.

The whole of the Soca valley has an interesting history as it was the setting of heavy fighting in World War 1 and in Kobarid (20 mins away) there is a Museum devoted to the period, and trenches from the Italian front line can be viewed in the course of many local walks.

Accommodation

The house has 2 double bedrooms and one twin bedroom. There is also a sofa in the sitting room which converts to another double bed - so the house will sleep 8 comfortably.

The Ground floor has utility room with a washing machine and drying / ironing facilities.

1st floor - There is an entrance hall with a shower room & WC. Off this hallway is one twin bedroom and one double bedroom.

The 2nd Floor has an airy sitting room / dining room & fully equipped kitchen. Bathroom with WC, shower and bath. There is a large sofa which converts to double bed, Cable TV and wireless internet access and a spiral staircase to the 3rd Floor which has a double bedroom.
