

CROATIA GEMS

Fishermans Cottage, Korcula Island, Dubrovnik Riviera

Sleeps 2 + 1 adult or 2 small children | 1 Double Bedroom plus Sofa bed | 1 Bathroom



Description

This rustic cottage is situated right on the sea edge in a secluded bay on the Island of Korcula. Surrounded by lush forest, this is a serene spot and perfect for getting away from it all - so if you want to spend a week playing Robinson Crusoe, this is the place for you! It has an utterly lovely location - you could easily believe you were the only ones on the island! Looking over to the Peljesac Peninsula the cottage is approximately 10 minutes by speed boat from Orebic and 10 minutes by car from Korcula town ferry port (it is the 3rd bay along from Korcula town) so is close to amenities and activities by car should you need or want them. Korcula Town is a beautiful little medieval town which juts into the Adriatic like a jewel. It is the apparent birthplace of Marco Polo and is often described as a mini-Dubrovnik. Its charming windy little streets are home to many enticing restaurants and cafes. There are also a couple of small fishing villages between the cottage and Korcula Town – they are approx 20 minutes by foot from the cottage.

This is a small and simply furnished cottage and with one double bedroom and is thus the perfect romantic bolthole to escape to... (If you do want to squeeze more people in though, then you can, as there is a sofa-bed in the living area).

BOAT

A boat is available with the property. It is a 4 meter boat with outboard motor. The boat is supplied by the owner and all arrangements are with him and not Croatia Gems although we will notify him if you would like to have the boat. **Costs are: 1-2 Days = 40 Euros per Day, 3-7 Days or more = 25 Euros per Day.** Please refer to your booking contract for boat hire regulation information.



Accommodation

- **Sleeps:** up to 4 people
- **Number of bedrooms:** 1 (sofa bed in other room)
- **Features of the house:** Fabulous bay and views across to the Peljesac Peninsula
- **Balconies/Terrace:** Terrace in front of house **Dining Room:** No
- **Garden:** Garden is the beach!
- **Number of Bathrooms:** 1 (Warm water shower only inside)
- **Parking/Garage, number of cars:** Parking on road 50 metres from house (room for 1 car – NB parking is not exclusive to the cottage)
- **Air Conditioning/Heating:** No but there are good shutters and the cottage has thick stone walls. There is also an open fireplace.
- **Other:** The cottage is powered by solar energy
- **BBQ** – there is a portable BBQ kept behind the cottage on which only charcoal must be used (it is prohibited to burn wood outside in Croatia from June 1st to September 1st due to the risk of forest fires), The fireplace inside the cottage is an indoor BBQ on which wood can be burned – wood is kept at the cottage for this purpose.
- **Mobility Rating:** 2 **Car recommended:** yes – a car is necessary at this property

Facilities and Amenities Nearby

- **Mini-supermarket:** 10 minutes drive or a by boat!
- **Restaurants, Pharmacy, Internet café, Bank::** 10 minutes drive (in Korcula)
- **Swimming & Beach:** Outside house
- **Korcula town & Car/Passenger ferry:** 15 minutes drive
- **Airport:** 2 hours (plus 10 minute ferry to Korcula and 10 minute drive once on the island) (Dubrovnik)

Please note that the cottage runs on solar power and as a result, water is only heated during daylight hours – given the solar nature of the system, it can also be unreliable. In the usual hot summer temperatures, this is not normally perceived as a problem by guests. The fridge, cooker and lights do function outside of that time but the electricity supply isn't as reliable as with mains electricity. The cottage isn't really suitable for rental outside of the summer season.

Please note that while the bay and beach is normally secluded, all beaches in Croatia are public and so others may use the beach.
