

## Villa Mirca, Island of Brac

Sleeps 6+2 | 1 double bedroom + 1 twin bedroom in main house | 1 bedroom in cottage | 2 bathrooms



### Description

Villa Mirca is situated in a beautiful olive grove in the village of Mirca on Brac. It is a traditional Dalmatian stone house with a sea view, which was completely renovated in 2009. This charming villa can accommodate 4 to 6 people. In the main house there is a kitchen / dining room / sitting room area, 2 bedrooms and a bathroom, whilst the cottage contains a studio with a kitchen / sitting room area (with an indoor fireplace) and a bathroom. In the spacious garden you can find many kinds of vegetables to enhance your cooking. To make your stay on Brac Island as pleasant as possible, the villa has been equipped with all the equipment you might need and the interior and grounds have been tastefully designed.

- Bedrooms: Bedroom 1 with double bed.- Bedroom 2 with twin beds.Studio area in the cottage with a double sofa bed.
- Bathrooms: Bathroom 1 with bath (massage) and WC. - Bathroom 2 with shower and WC. ( cottage)

This island of stone, sea and sunshine is the largest in central Dalmatia. Brac Island has craggy shores and brown rocks, but also boasts wonderful beaches, such as Zlatni Rat (Golden Tongue), a spectacular jewel of nature. The limestone karst and scrub alternate with fertile fields in the interior and pine woods on the heights. Villages scattered along the coast and in the interior of Brac Island are like stone monuments, guarding the rich heritage of the past centuries. Brac Island has had many rulers during its history, but its spirit remains unchanged and is best expressed in its most enduring product – the famous Brac stone. Some of that spirit has been incorporated in historical buildings, such as Diocletian's Palace in Split, and more modern edifices, such as The White House in Washington.
